

Drop off and pick up

Parents will receive allocated drop off and pick up times and are asked to maintain social distancing while waiting. Where possible, parents should not come into the setting but instead drop off and collect at the door.



Visitors

All visitors are required to book an appointment with the setting manager and visit, at the manager's discretion, after closing. PPE must be worn at all times and must be provided by the visitor.

PPE

S4YC have provided face coverings for our staff to wear if they choose to do so.

Government guidelines do not advise staff in education and early years settings to wear any extra PPE.

Where a child is unwell or staff are dealing with bodily fluids PPE will be worn.



Health and Safety Measures Covid 19 Return to Setting Leaflet

'Bubble'

As advised by the government, children will remain within a "bubble" throughout the session with an allocated key person and a small group of children.

Activities and Resources

Activities and resources may look slightly different as we have taken away sand, water, playdough, messy play, soft toys and dressing up, cushions and hard to clean toys to minimise spread of infection.

Activities will take place in "bubbles" and resources will be thoroughly cleaned after each activity.

Activities have been carefully planned in accordance with new risk assessments taking into account government guidance regarding Covid 19 and children's mental and physical wellbeing.

Infection Control Measures Include...

- Rigorous handwashing throughout the day
- Snuffle stations at to each setting
- Staff training on infection control
- Taking children/staff temperatures prior to the session.
- Regular cleaning of environment and resources.
- Keeping personal belongings outside of the setting (where possible)

Risk Assessments and Staff Training

On returning to work, all staff will all have training on our new protocols as well as undertaking Covid 19 and infection control training as part of their return to work induction. New Risk assessments



have been shared and approved by all settings and staff.

Bags and lunch boxes

Please place your child lunch in a clearly labelled plastic food bag .

We will be asking that children's bags and belongings are placed into a container at the entrance to the setting where they will remain for the week.

Staff members will hand over any laundry/wet clothes to you at the end of the day. Please bring in replacements as required.

Home Learning

Your child's key person will work closely with you to support your child's learning and development.



Please continue to share with us any achievements and interests your child has made during their time at home so that we can work together to support you and your child.
